The 67th Hokudai-sai Safety Management Rules

1. Introduction

To ensure the safe and smooth operation of the 67th Hokudai-sai, the Hokkaido University Festival Executive Committee (For short: Hokudai-sai Committee) will impose appropriate penalties on participating groups that commit acts obstructing this purpose (hereinafter referred to as “violations”).

The participating groups in the 67th Hokudai-sai must comply with the penalties and other matters described below.

2. Overview

The following five penalties will be imposed on the participating groups that commit violations:

① Advisory Warning

If Hokudai-sai Staff determine that a participating group’s actions are highly likely to interfere with the safe operation of the Hokudai-sai, they will give the participating group a warning, provide guidance, and request improvement.

② Violation Points

Violation Points are points given to participating groups that commit violations. If no improvement is seen despite an Advisory Warning, Violation Points will be issued. However, if Hokudai-sai Staff judge that the violation poses significant danger or urgency, points may be issued without prior warning. Violation Points are accumulated during the 67th Hokudai-sai. If a certain threshold is exceeded, the participating group will receive a Temporary Suspension or Permanent Suspension. Points will not be reduced except upon the lifting of a Temporary Suspension.

③ Compensation

If a participating group damages equipment or materials owned by Hokkaido University, any faculty, the Hokudai-sai Committee, Each Festival Executive Committee, or the Hokudai-sai Office—or damages items that are required or requested to be installed for the safety of the Hokudai-sai—the Hokudai-sai Committee, relevant Executive Festival Committee of Each Festival, or Hokudai-sai Office will demand compensation based on the distributed materials.

④ Temporary Suspension

This penalty is imposed when a participating group accumulates 30 Violation Points. Once the penalty is decided, the participating group must suspend business for 2 hours from the time of the notice. However, if less than 2 hours remain in that day's Business Hours at the time of notice, the participating group must suspend business for the rest of the day. If the notice is given during Late Night During Hokudai-sai, the suspension will begin from the next Business Hours for 2 hours. The lifting of the suspension and the procedure for business resumption must be conducted in the presence of either the Chair or Vice Chair of the Hokudai-sai Committee and at least one of either the participating group’s Leader or the Vice Leader. During the suspension period, the use of Fire Equipment is generally prohibited. However, as an exception, the operation of Generators solely for the purpose of running refrigerators or freezers is allowed (Use of Generators for any other purpose is strictly prohibited). Upon lifting of the suspension, regardless of the previously accumulated Violation Points, the participating group will restart business with 10 Violation Points.

⑤ Permanent Suspension

This penalty is imposed when a participating group accumulates 50 Violation Points. Once

this penalty is decided, the participating group must immediately cease business and begin removing their Section. All further activity by the participating group during the 67th Hokudai-sai will be prohibited from the time the permanent suspension notice is given.

3. Notification Process

① Advisory Warning

Delivered directly to the participating group by Hokudai-sai Staff.

② Issue of Violation Points

Delivered directly by Hokudai-sai Staff. Additionally, the Chair of the Hokudai-sai Committee will request the Executive Committee of Each Festival to notify the participating group's Leader by email regarding the issue of Violation Points.

③ Request for Payment of Compensation

Delivered directly by Hokudai-sai Staff. The Chair of Hokudai-sai Committee will confirm the compensation purpose and payment destination, then request the Executive Committee of Each Festival to notify the participating group's Leader by email regarding the details.

④ Temporary Suspension

Delivered directly by Hokudai-sai Staff to the participating group that accumulated 30 Violation Points. The Chair of the Hokudai-sai Committee will then notify both the Executive Committee of Each Festival and the relevant participating group's Leader directly or by email.

⑤ Permanent Suspension

Delivered directly by the Chair or Vice Chair of the Hokudai-sai Committee to the participating group that accumulated 50 Violation Points. The Chair of Hokudai-sai Committee will then notify both the Executive Committee of Each Festival and the relevant participating group's Leader directly or by email.

4. Details of Violation Points

5. Notes

- Violation Points are cumulative during the 67th Hokudai-sai and carry over to the following day.
- These regulations correspond to the “regulations and provisions set by the Hokudai-sai Committee” stated in Clause 1 of the PLEDGE for the 67th Hokudai-sai.
- In this document, “During Hokudai-sai” refers to June 5 (Thu) 18:00 – June 9 (Mon) 6:00.
- “Activity Hours” refers to the Available Activity Hours during Hokudai-sai.
- “Late Night During Hokudai-sai” refers to the period outside a participating group's Activity Hours.
- In this document, “Outdoor” indicates that the rule applies to outdoor participating groups.
- In this document, “Indoor” indicates that the rule applies to indoor participating groups.
- In this document, “All participating groups” indicates that the rule applies to all participating groups, both indoor and outdoor.

	Penalty	Immediately stop the use of Fire Equipment. Violation Points +30 <i>Depending on the amount of gasoline leaked, a Temporary Suspension may exceed 2 hours.</i>

	Period	During Activity Hours	Section	Outdoor
	Violation Details	Not complying with restrictions on the use of Fire Equipment or Generators issued by Hokudai-sai Staff for fire prevention when gasoline was leaked by a group in a nearby Section.		
	Reason/ Note	There is an extremely high risk of a large-scale fire. <i>If there are safety concerns, even participating groups that did not cause the gasoline leak may be asked to delay resuming activity for a long time.</i> <i>The Hokudai-sai Committee bears no responsibility for any opportunity loss caused by gasoline leaks or fires from nearby participating groups.</i>		
	Penalty	Violation Points +30 <i>Depending on the severity of the gasoline leak or fire, Temporary Suspension may last more than 2 hours.</i>

	Violation Details	Storing gasoline in something other than a gasoline container.		
	Reason/ Note	This is stipulated in Article 16 of the Fire Services Act.

	Violation Details	The cap of the gasoline container is not closed.		
	Reason/ Note	There is an extremely high risk of gasoline igniting and causing a fire.

	Reason/ Note	There is a high risk of the decorations catching fire.

	Violation Details	There is not enough space between fluorescent lights and decorations.		
	Reason/ Note	The heat from the fluorescent lights could cause the decorations to catch fire.

	Violation Details	The Fire Extinguisher has been damaged or lost.		
	Reason/ Note	It would no longer be possible to respond in the event of a fire.		
	Penalty	Pay a compensation fee of 6,000 yen for the Fire Extinguisher. Violation Points Issued

	Period	During Hokudai-sai	Section	All Participating Groups
	Violation Details	Although the participating group is designated as a Fire Extinguisher Zone, the Fire Extinguisher Zone Certificate is not displayed.		
	Reason/ Note	It becomes impossible to confirm whether the Fire Extinguisher is correctly installed.		
	Penalty	Violation Points Issued

	Period	During Hokudai-sai	Section	All Participating Groups
	Violation Details	Although designated to receive a fire extinguisher, the fire extinguisher has not been picked up.		
	Reason/ Note	If the Fire Extinguisher is not placed in the Fire Extinguisher Zone, response in the event of a fire will be delayed.		
	Penalty	Violation Points Issued

	Period	During Hokudai-sai	Section	All Participating Groups
	Violation Details	Misuse of the dedicated refrigerator power source.		
	Reason/ Note	Exceeding the power limit causes inconvenience to other participants and visitors.

	Period	During Activity Hours	Section	All Participating Groups
	Violation Details	Generator was not placed outside the tent.		
	Reason/ Note	There is a very high risk of carbon monoxide poisoning or fire from operating a generator inside the tent.

The decision to resume business shall follow the judgment of the Hokudai-sai Committee.</i>

	Reason/ Note	At the Garbage Station, Hokudai-sai Staff provide guidance on trash separation for sanitation management and environmental consideration so that visitors can enjoy the Hokudai-sai comfortably; therefore, disposal of trash during Late Night During Hokudai-sai, when staff are not present, is prohibited. If trash is disposed of selfishly, it may cause littering, foul odors, or damage by crows. For this reason, all participants must take their trash home during Late Night during Hokudai-sai.
