Hygiene Safety Meeting

[Food service regulations]

- raw meat, seafood, or eggs must not be served
- do not cut or skewer raw meat or seafood inside the tent
- uncooked vegetables must not be served
- use canned fruits
- Homemade whipped cream is not allowed

Hygiene Safety Meeting

- [Food Preparation and Storage]
- $\boldsymbol{\cdot}$ Do not prepare or cook food the day before
- $\boldsymbol{\cdot}$ do not leave food at room temperature
- •do not carry ingredients over to the next day
- •Fermentation using yeast, etc. is strictly prohibited
- •set up a Mini Water Station inside the tent
- \cdot Using knives or other blades inside the tent is prohibited

[About ordering process]

•Please submit the Rental Equipment Order Form on the official website by **May 1st (Thursday) at 11:50 PM**

[Cautions]

•Gas orders \rightarrow Rental Equipment Order Form.

Renting gas outside of this process is strictly prohibited.

•For tents, prepare side panels for all four sides. Tent size must not exceed **2.7m × 3.6m**

•Do not lend out any rental items you received from the Co-op to other groups.

• Rental Equipment Order Confirmation Session: GA#4 (5/9 Friday)

•You will receive a *Reservation Slip* and an *LP Gas Delivery Slip* from the rental company. Keep them safe.

[About payment process]

Date: 5/17 (Monday) ~ 5/23 (Friday)

Location: Travel Center on the 2nd floor of the North Cafeteria

Cautions: Payment must be **cash and in full. No Credit cards.**

Please make sure to watch the generator and gas instruction videos that will be shared via IFF Guide.





If your group is planning to rent a 10kg propane gas, remain seated after today's GA ends.

•You can purchase containers and ice through the Hokudai-sai Office.

•Please refer to the *Container and Ice Catalog* (available on the IFF Web)for information on types, quantities, and prices.

How to place an order.

- •Orders can be placed through the *Container and Ice Order Form* on the IFF Web.
- •The submission period is **from April 21 at 20:00 to May 1 at 23:50**.
- \cdot Make sure to submit your order within this period.

•You will be asked to pay for the containers and ice at GA#4

•Please check the total amount on the *Container and Ice Order Form* and **bring the exact amount—no change will be provided.**

How to pick up

[Container Pickup]

Date and time: Thursday, June 5, from 18:30 to 20:30(only one opportunity)

Location: the first floor of the Information Education Building

Cautions: Make sure to come with multiple people

Be sure to bring your Container and Ice PASS with you

[Ice pick up]

Date and time: at the date and time you selected on the Order Form

Location: the first floor of the Information Education Building(same as for containers)

Caution: Be sure to bring your *Container and Ice PASS* with you.

• Please make sure to read it carefully

About Cooking Equipment Application

•Cooking Equipment Application \rightarrow for Fire Department and Fire Safety Staff to understand the fire- using equipment.

• Concrete blocks and Fireproof Boards \rightarrow distributed based on the application.

• You **must** <u>use these concrete block and Fireproof boards when using cooking</u> <u>equipment</u>.

•Not using provided concrete blocks and Fireproof boards Using cooking equipment not declared in the application



About Cooking Equipment Application

- •Application
- \rightarrow Via the IFF Web
- Application Period
- \rightarrow From April 21th (today) to May 1st 23:50

(You can make changes during the period)

•No change after the application period ends (If absolutely necessary, contact the IFF Staff)

- [Standard Entry Rules Do Not Apply]
- During the festival period(from June 5 to 8):
- •Hokkaido University's standard entry rules will not apply.
- •You must follow the special entry rules set for the Hokudai-sai.

[For Groups Using Vehicles]

You must apply for a Car Pass in advance
Car Pass applications must be submitted through the IFF Web.
Passes will be distributed to approved groups at GA#7 on June 2nd.
Each group may have no more than two vehicles inside the campus at the same time.

[3. Time Slots When Vehicles Are Allowed to Drive on Campus


Hokudai-sai	Date	Vehicle entry/ driving Hours
Day 1	6/6 (Friday)	$7:00 \sim 12:00$ (last entry by 11:30), $21:00 \sim 22:00$
Day 2	6/7 (Saturday)	$7:00 \sim 9:00, 21:00 \sim 22:00$
Day3	6/8 (Sunday)	$7:00 \sim 9:00, 17:00 \sim 19:00$ (last entry by 18:30)

Driving vehicles on campus out of these time slots is strictly prohibited.

[4. IFF-Designated Parking Lot and Detour Route]

•If you need to park your vehicle, **please use the IFF-designated parking lot located on the west side of the Science Building 5.**

•U-turns on the Main Street are strictly prohibited.


